- √ Valid government issued photo identification and Social Security Numbers for all individuals that will be authorized to transact business on behalf of the company and/or authorized signers on the account
- ✓ An Employer Identification Number (EIN) or tax ID number that is registered to your business. To request and EIN, call 1-800-829-4933 or go to http://www.irs.gov Note: Sole Proprietorships may choose to use the owner's Social Security number.
- ✓ The legal document that shows when the company was formed. (Articles of Incorporation, Articles of Organization, Charter, Fictitious Business Name Statement or Assumed Name Certificate, etc.)

Based on the structure of your business, the legal documentation listed will be required at the time your account is opened.

The resolution needs to be signed by all of the individuals that are owners/officers of the business, as well as individuals who will be authorized to sign on the depository account.
